Running eight foodbanks in the North West, Central and East parts of Edinburgh requires a turnover of nearly 100,000 tonnes of food a year – all of which is donated by schools, faith groups, companies and individuals. Many of our donations are collected by our volunteers using our little foodbank van and then redistributed to our centres using our trailer.

In recent months we have almost doubled how many supermarkets we partner with. We are therefore looking to expand our transport team to help with the extra collections and are looking for an enthusiastic and committed volunteer to join the team.
